| R v Morphy and Morphy: | A News of the World expose of a country house brothel. Issues of entrapment and whether the proprietors controlled the girls. Also involved financial confiscation and the case was recently back in the Court of Appeal as a Criminal Cases Review Commission referral on the issue of calculation of benefit for the purpose of financial confiscation. |
